

— CHECK IT OUT... “**GENEROUS**” IN GOD’S WORD —

---

**DEUTERONOMY 15:10**

Give **generously** to him and do so without a grudging heart; then because of this the LORD your God will bless you in all your work and in everything you put your hand to.

---

**1 CHRONICLES 29:14**

"But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as **generously** as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand.

---

**2 CHRONICLES 31:5**

As soon as the order went out, the Israelites **generously** gave the firstfruits of their grain, new wine, oil and honey and all that the fields produced. They brought a great amount, a tithe of everything.

---

**PSALM 37:21**

The wicked borrow and do not repay, but the righteous give **generously**;

---

**PSALM 37:26**

They are always **generous** and lend freely; their children will be blessed.

---

**PSALM 112:5**

Good will come to him who is **generous** and lends freely, who conducts his affairs with justice.

---

**PROVERBS 11:25**

A **generous** man will prosper; he who refreshes others will himself be refreshed.

---

**PROVERBS 22:9**

A **generous** man will himself be blessed, for he shares his food with the poor.

---

**MATTHEW 20:15**

Don't I have the right to do what I want with my own money? Or are you envious because I am **generous**?'

---

**ACTS 10:2**

He and all his family were devout and God-fearing; he gave **generously** to those in need and prayed to God regularly.

---

**ROMANS 12:8**

if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give **generously**; if it is leadership, let him govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully.

---

**2 CORINTHIANS 9:5**

So I thought it necessary to urge the brothers to visit you in advance and finish the arrangements for the **generous** gift you had promised. Then it will be ready as a **generous** gift, not as one grudgingly given.

---

**2 CORINTHIANS 9:6**

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows **generously** will also reap **generously**.

---

**2 CORINTHIANS 9:11**

You will be made rich in every way so that you can be **generous** on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

---

**1 TIMOTHY 6:18**

Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be **generous** and willing to share.

---

**JAMES 1:5**

If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives **generously** to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him.

Living Generously means spending yourself for the benefit of others.
